Laboratory regulations regarding safety rules during the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic

- 1. Only a healthy person who has no symptoms suggesting an infectious disease may stay in the laboratory. Persons who stay at home with a person who is in quarantine or home isolation, and persons who are in quarantine or home isolation cannot participate in classes.
- 2. Students are not allowed to enter the laboratory in the absence of a teacher.
- 3. A distance of 2 metres between persons should be kept when entering/leaving the laboratory.
- 4. The outerwear should be left in the cloakroom.
- 5. The use of cell phones is not allowed in the laboratory.
- 6. It is obligatory to disinfect hands before classes.
- 7. Only a person with a mouth and nose cover may stay in the laboratory (a face mask or a face shield for people who cannot cover their mouth and nose with the face mask for health reasons).
- 8. The safe distance of 2 metres between persons should be kept in the laboratory.
- 9. If possible, each person should use their own tools/utensils (i.e. a pen, notebook). It is forbidden to borrow other participants' tools.
- 10. It is forbidden to eat during classes.
- 11. After classes, hands should be disinfected with a disinfectant.
- 12. The laboratory should be ventilated regularly, at least once an hour. If possible, it is recommended to conduct classes with open windows.
- 13. The door to the laboratory and all rooms used by students should be open.
- 14. Door handles, handles, seats, laboratory equipment and frequently touched surfaces should be disinfected regularly.
- 15. Disinfection is carried out strictly in accordance with the recommendations of the manufacturer of the disinfectant and disinfection equipment.
