CIRCULAR NO. 4/2022

of the Rector of the Wroclaw University of Economics and Business

of 15 June 2022

on establishing the list of elective courses in the humanities

in undergraduate and graduate programmes

§1

- 1. It is established that, starting from the academic year 2022/2023, the elective courses in the humanities are as follows:
- a) in undergraduate programmes in Polish: philosophy, economic history of Poland and the world before 1939, humanistic concepts of individuals, cultural changes, megatrends in creative space, ethics of influence and manipulation;
- b) **in graduate programmes in Polish:** philosophy of culture, economic history of Poland and the world after 1939, anthropological and cultural concepts of individuals, cultural value of work
- c) <u>in undergraduate programmes in English</u>: except for finance: humanistic concept of individuals, philosophy, economic history, megatrends in creative space, cultural changes;
- d) in graduate programmes in English, except for finance: philosophy, history of pop culture, economic history.
- 2. Students of programmes in Polish who have completed the course in economic history cannot choose the course in economic history of Poland and the world before 1939 and the course in economic history of Poland and the world after 1939.
- 3. Students of graduate programmes in English cannot reselect a course completed as part of the undergraduate programme.
- 4. The Dean of the Branch establishes a list of elective courses in the humanities for students of the Branch.
